Activity Description: BOP Industries intends to use Canterbury College for a full day excursion on the 26th of July 2024. The program will see approx. 100-120 students in year 7-10 to participate in a program exploring schooling in the future. Throughout the programs students will be working with equipment provided by BOP Industries including pens and paper, and other stationary. Throughout the program students will be predominantly working at tables and chairs with the majority of content being delivered by a BOP Industries facilitator via projector. Description of hazards/risks	Risk level	Control measures
Exposure to COVID-19	Low	All COVID-19 governmental procedures and processes will be followed to ensure that exposure to COVID-19 is as controlled as possible. Students and staff are encouraged to not attend if they have any symptoms.
Slips, Trips Or Falls Over AV Equipment	Low	All equipment will be monitored by the BOP team to ensure that no hazards are present from this equipment. Students will also be reminded by the BOP team to use their common sense when walking around the space and picking up and clearing up their equipment. First Aid equipment will also be on site for any injuries.
Access To Unfiltered Internet - As part of the program, students will be encouraged to bring devices or to use the BOP Industries iPads to access research and create designs.	Low	Students will be under strict instruction and supervision from the BOP Industries team and will be monitored throughout the duration of the day. They will also be asked to pack away their devices when they are not being used for any activity.
Any Risk To Students Attending	Low	All facilitators have appropriate accreditation, blue cards and are insured under BOPs Public Liability and Professional Indemnity Insurance.
